## Detailed Plan:

Day 1:

- Arrived in Hiroshima. Travel to hotel by themselves

## Day 2:

- We see at our school for orientation.
- 1 hour of koto lesson (Introduction to the instrument, etc.)
- Cultural tour to Hiroshima Castle.



## Day 3 - 6:

- Class starts at 10am (2 hours koto lesson)
- 12pm – 1 hour break
- 1pm – Experimental with the instrument (Learn how to tune, etc.)
- 2pm – Japanese language class using a textbook (Learn basic Japanese like greetings, and also some words or musical terms used in playing the koto)
- 3pm – Self-study of koto

## Day 7:

- 9am – Go to Kimono rental + visit Japanese traditional garden called Shukkeien
- 1pm – Practice for the recital
- 2pm – Recital (including teacher performance)
- 3pm – Farewell party



## Course Fee:

- Tuition fee (including kimono rental, visiting Hiroshima Castle & Shukkeien, and our facilities): 99,000 yen
- Textbook fee: 11,000 yen

## Life Expenses:

- Hotel: From around 6,000 yen / day \*Depends on season
- Meals: From around 1,000 yen / day

\*Hiroshima Castle & Shukkeien are walkable from our school

\*Transportation fee (Airplane ticket and domestic travel) is not included
